Youth Benefits



The Boy Scout Merit Badge Sponsorship Program provides opportunities for at-risk youth in low-income and culturally diverse areas to grow physically, mentally, and morally in after-school and weekend activities. The Scouting program is a year-round effort because the pressures on our young people increase every day. There is no better time than now to help guide youth in positive directions.

Scouting addresses the Peninsula's at-risk youth in the following ways:

1. Offering a place for youth to meet after school and on weekends and learn how to be physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight.
2. Teaching the youth how to avoid drug and alcohol abuse through the "Drugs: A Deadly Game" program.
3. Going on fun and educational "field trips" to local museums, parks and libraries.
4. Participating in meaningful day camp, resident camp and weekend camping trips.
5. Creating weekly opportunities at group meetings to learn values that include: being trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, and reverent.

Additionally, Scouting helps the Peninsula's at-risk youth to develop six critical characteristics of healthy youth:

1. Strong personal values and character
2. Positive sense of self-worth and usefulness
3. Caring and nurturing relationships with parents, other adults and peers
4. A desire to learn
5. Productive/creative use of time
6. Social adeptness

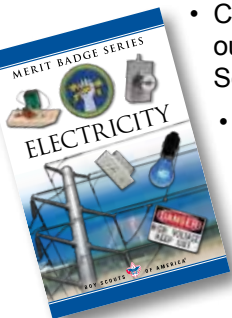
