



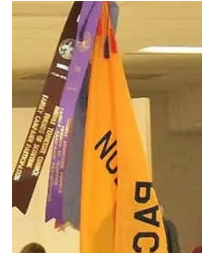
2022 Cub Scout Fall Recruiting Blitz!

Tier 1: Your Pack recruits more Scouts than it did in 2021

Tier 1 Incentive: Ribbon for Pack Flag



Tier 2: Your Pack recruits 10% more Scouts than it did in 2021

Tier 2 Incentive: Raingutter Regatta Track



Tier 3: Your Pack recruits 20% more Scouts than it did in 2021

Tier 3 Incentive: Two Free Nights at Cutter or Boulder Creek



Fine Print

- Recruiting numbers are based on official council numbers recorded in my.scouting.org
- You can check the numbers you need to meet each tier by checking with your District Director
- Packs must recruit one Scout more in the fall of 2022 than the Pack recruited in the fall of 2021 to qualify for the Ribbon for Pack Flag
- Packs must recruit 10% more Scouts in the fall of 2022 than it recruited in the fall of 2021 to qualify for the Inflatable Raingutter Track
- Packs must recruit 20% more scouts in the fall of 2022 than it recruited in the fall of 2021 to qualify free two camping nights at either Cutter Scout Reservation or Boulder Creek Scout Reservation in 2023 or 2024
- Fall is defined as August - December
- Cutter Scout Reservation is currently closed due to fire damage. We are working to reopen Cutter in 2023 for "Primitive Camping", but many factors will determine if that is possible. Should Cutter remain closed, the certificate can be used at Boulder Creek Scout Reservation on open camping weekends.
- The camping certificate will be valid at Cutter Scout Reservation or Boulder Creek Scout Reservation in 2023 or 2024
- The Camping Certificate is only valid for the reservation and use of land (campsite). It does not include program areas, tents, or supplies.
